Lockers and Locker Search

Students are to use **only** the locker and lock assigned to them. All lockers will have a school lock on them. Remember, if you bring a lock from home, the district cannot be responsible for lost keys or combinations.

To help insure the safety of your personal belongings, **lockers are to be locked** at all times that you are not present at your locker. BUS RESPONSIBILITIES FOR STUDENTS

SAFETY is the primary concern of the transportation department. Therefore, we ask that all students and parents agree to do their part to keep the ride to and from school a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone. With that in mind please remember, **riding a school bus is a privilege.**

If all the students remember the rules of common courtesy and obey the bus driver immediately, at all times, we will have a fun, safe year. However, **failure on the part of the students to obey the driver or promote a safe bus environment could result in the loss of bus riding privileges.**

Parents and students please read the following list of information. All who are transported with Basin School District are responsible to know the following:

1. Students are responsible to be on time for the bus. Being on time for the bus means that you will be at the stop five minutes before the scheduled leave time. **The bus driver will leave students who are not on time for the bus.**
2. If the student misses the bus they should arrange for transportation to one of the next scheduled stops. For safety reasons **bus drivers cannot stop anywhere except at pre-approved stops.**
3. Only approach the bus to load or unload.
4. If necessary to cross the road at your stop, cross fifteen (15) feet in front of the bus and wait at the right edge of the roadway for a signal from the bus driver before proceeding into the traffic lanes.
5. **Students may only depart the bus at their assigned stop** unless they have a parent/guardian's written permission.
6. If a student is going to ride on a bus that is not their assigned bus, a parent/guardian must contact the transportation department at least 24 hours in advance.

Please remember we are committed to not only the safety of those riding the bus, but all members of our community.
