PSAT

All sophomores and some juniors will be taking the PSAT on October 16th. The PSAT is the "Preliminary (practice)" SAT, which is a college entrance exam. The PSAT is FREE for all sophomores and \$17 for any junior that wishes to take it for more practice. Most colleges require the SAT or ACT as an admission requirement. Taking the SAT (or ACT) is also a graduation requirement in the state of Idaho. Please try to ensure your child(ren) is at school this day, as there is no make up time/days for this test.

Homework Club

Basin District Wellness Center - UPDATED

Basin School District has recently adopted the Community Schools model. What this means is we are partnering with community, county, Treasure Valley and even statewide individuals and agencies to bring to campus the needed resources and services we think our students and families would benefit from. We hope to break down barriers and improve access to needed things such as basic necessities - clothes/shoes, hygiene and household supplies, school supplies, warm winter gear as well as dental, mental and primary health care. Located in one of our modular buildings on campus is the Basin School District Wellness Center which houses a student 'store' with shelves of donated basic needs items, a private counseling office and a medical clinic space. Bundy Moore is the Community Schools / Wellness Center Coordinator and can help connect students and families with resources as needed. Bundy is on campus Monday, Wednesday, Friday each week and can be reached at bmoore@basinschools.net or by calling the district office at 208-392-4183. Please let Bundy know if your family could use assistance.

Garden Valley Family Medicine leases the medical clinic space and are open every Wednesday and the first Tuesday of every month. The health care clinic is open to the community with the exception of registered sex offenders as it is located on school campus.

School Resource Officer (SRO) David Gomez

See this section for the latest updates and suggestions from SRO David Gomez for online safety and drug and alcohol safety. Blurbs taken from his Facebook page:

A little bit of information before parents get too reliant on parental controls on a kids phone. These hacks are common knowledge among middle school / high school kids who have smart phones. These are for Apple products.

- 1) Application screen-time restrictions: As a parent you can set how much time your child gets to spend on each application on their apple product. Kids know to delete the application after their time runs out and then re-download the application to start the time over. Parent Fix: Remove kids ability to download applications without your password.
- 2) Sleep Time: Parents can set times when kids are not supposed to be on their phones such as during sleep hours or school hours. Kids know they can change the date/time setting on their clock to bypass the hours restricted. So kids can set the phone to think it is noon when it is really midnight. There is no fix to this other than keeping phones on a central charging station at night or in the parents room.
- 3) Youtube block: Parents can block youtube so kids can not watch youtube at all on their phones. Kids have friends send them youtube video's to their iMessage which will play the youtube video without using the YouTube application.

The best solution always is to communicate with your children and be aware of what they are doing. An even better solution is to spend a lot of family time with your kids so they are not bored and on their devices.
